Year 11 – GCSE Reminder

Thursday: GCSE exams begin.

All pupils should now have received their formal exams timetable – please check these carefully. You will also find a full timetable detailing all the exams being sat at CFS on the [school website](#).

- Formal written exams start on the 9th May
- Morning exams, pupils must be on site and ready to enter the exam hall by 8:15 to start at 8:30,
- Afternoon exams pupils must be on site and ready to enter the exam hall by 13:30 to start at 13:45, - this means some pupils with extra time may finish after the end of the usual school day.
- All pupils are expected in school as normal until after the half term.
- Optional study leave begins after half term (3rd June)
- Pupils must attend school up to half term in full uniform (leavers hoodies are allowed in place of blazers)

From **Monday 3rd June** pupils can attend in non-school uniform if they wish (this must be appropriate for a school environment).
