For those parents that have their child out on a 'Work Experience' placement, please check on Unifrog that the Parent/Guardian sign off (Stage 3) has been done. If Unifrog is still at Stage 2, this will require you to get in touch with the employer and ask them to complete it (mention that the email from Unifrog may have fallen into Junk). Without Unifrog going through all four Stages, the placement will not be able to take place. The process is automated and via email addresses. A reminder of the four stages: 1- pupil puts placement on Unifrog; 2- employer puts information on Unifrog about the palcement and risk assessments in place; 3- parent sees this information and confirms happy; 4- school see this information and confirms happy.
