NOTICE

We have been asked to share some important information with all parents regarding financially motivated sexual extortion: alert from the National Crime Agency

Globally, there has been a large increase in reports of children and young people being forced into paying money or meeting another financial demand (such as purchasing a pre-paid gift card) after an offender has threatened to release nudes or semi-nudes of them. This is financially motivated sexual extortion, a type of online blackmail often referred to in the media as 'sextortion'. It is a form of child sexual abuse. Financially motivated sexual extortion is usually carried out by organised crime groups (OCGs) based overseas who are typically motivated by money. These groups target all ages and genders however, a large proportion of cases have involved male victims aged 14-18. As a school we have been asked to share the attached letter from the National Crime Agency which gives further detail and support to enable you to talk to your child about financially motivated sexual extortion and understand how you can help them if they become a victim.
