



TTRS AT CFS



At CFS, we prioritise children developing fluency when recalling multiplication and division facts. One of our approaches to this is the use of the fantastic platform 'Times Tables Rock Stars'.

Every week in assembly, a trophy is awarded to the winning band (class) who have answered the most amount of questions correctly over the past seven days. Certificate are also awarded to the top three players in the Primary Phase.



We aim is to keep the 'hype' around TTRS all year. We have 'rockstar' days and regular competitions that run throughout the year, such as designing a rock hero badge for our children to wear with pride.

An in-school research project suggested that children at CFS are more likely to become fluent in accurately recalling multiplication facts if they play TTRS regularly.



Based on our Mean Studio Speed, Chichester Free School is the fastest school in the local area.

Additionally, we regularly take part in nation-wide competitions, such as England Rocks. Recently, CFS placed 22nd out of over 3,500 schools!
