Year 3 Trip to Fishbourne Roman Palace – Thursday 30th January 2025

As part of our exploration into the 'Gruesome Gladiators' topic, Year 3 pupils will be visiting Fishbourne Roman Palace. This trip is designed to enrich their understanding of the impact the invading Romans had on the local area. During this visit, pupils will have the unique opportunity to observe authentic Roman artefacts, explore the museum, admire intricate mosaics as well as learn about the building of a Roman villa. It promises to be an immersive experience that will deepen their knowledge and bring history to life.

Pupils must come to school as normal and in uniform. We will travel to and from the Palace by school minibus during the school day

Cost and payment details:

The cost of the visit is **£10** but you will not need to contribute if you paid the annual Primary Trip contribution at the beginning of the school year. You would have also consented when you made this payment. If there is a change to any medical information since consent, please do let your child's class teacher know.

Those parents not having paid this annual contribution– If your child would like to take part in this workshop, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£10** to cover the cost of the visit.

Payment should be made on the School's ParentPay system, where you can also give consent for your child to participate. If you do not have access to ParentPay, or are unsure if you made an annual contribution, please contact the finance office.

If insufficient voluntary contributions are made, then it is unlikely that the experience will go ahead. Please contact the school if you would like your child to participate but you have difficulty with making the contribution.

Should your child not wish to attend this trip, they must still attend school and alternative provisions will be made. Normal school procedures will be followed through for non-attendance in school.

Items to Take:

Please provide your child with a packed lunch and water bottle in an easy to carry bag such as a rucksack. If your child is in receipt of FSM provision and they require a packed lunch then you must email your child's class teacher no later than Monday 27th January so that this can be arranged.
